Position Overview

Lead the mobilization team to identify, recruit, evaluate, pray with and deploy long and short-term missionaries and other workers to Europe. This includes creating the vision for, and implementing a robust long term mobilization program, representing ECMI-USA at appropriate mobilization venues, maintaining a vigorous online web and social media presence, and directing and supervising the mobilization team.

Primary Job Functions

- Manage the mobilization and application process
- Stay abreast and knowledgeable of latest missiological trends and lead the evaluation and continuous improvements of the mobilization strategies and tactics.
- Coordinate applicant interest with field needs
- Mobilize, pray with, encourage, and coach candidates
- Track and monitor the mobilization process, which concludes with candidates' appointment.
- Continuously improve the timeliness and efficiency of the mobilization process.
- Maintain secure online data base of contact/ candidate information
- Organize and lead a personal prayer support team
- Either be a self-funded volunteer or obtain and maintain 100% of required pay/ funding by way of ministry partnerships
- Participate in weekly staff conference calls

Secondary Job Functions

- Represent ECMI-USA at seminaries, Christian and secular colleges, churches, and mobilization/ recruiting events.
- Oversee the ECMI-USA Short Term Missions program and its Coordinator
- Attend the ECMI Biennial conference

Requirements and Skills

- Demonstrate a mature and consistent Christian commitment and walk with the Lord
- Agree with and adhere to the ECMI statement of faith, policies and practices

- Able to work with people from a broad theological spectrum of evangelical positions and practices
- Demonstrates the ability to connect with and relate to all generations of inquirers
- College level training, including at least 30 credits of Bible and Theology
- Short and/or long term field missionary experience
- Knowledgeable in cross cultural and missiological issues
- Experience and knowledge in event planning
- Able to communicate clearly both in writing and verbally
- Able to interact personably with people in various settings
- Be a team player and self-starter with supervisory experience
- Proficient computer literacy to communicate comfortably via social media, video teleconferencing, digital publishing and email
- Competent in the use of online database technology, word processing, and spreadsheets
- If not in Colorado Springs, CO, then requires office space at home, high speed internet connection with adequate bandwidth for video, voice and data communications
- Must be willing and able to travel at least 25% of the time and travel to Europe at least one time per year

- Liaises with Field Ministry Personnel, US Staff and other ECMI personnel as needed
